TOPIC

"Air Quality Management"

Air quality affects our everyday life and economic growth. Air quality in this area has continually improved despite an enormous increase in population and cars. For example, maximum levels of ozone, one of our worst smog problems, have been cut to less than one quarter of what they were in the 1950s, even though today we have nearly three times as many people and four times as many vehicles. However, the clean air effort still has a long way to go. We are still breathing the nations' worst air quality.
